

## **Chesterfield County Stormwater Academy**

The Chesterfield County Department of Environmental Engineering is partnering with the Friends of Chesterfield's Riverfront to offer an interactive program to educate citizens about the concepts of watersheds and non-point source pollution. Individuals will learn simple steps to reduce and treat their own runoff and protect water quality in Chesterfield County and the Chesapeake Bay.

Academy participants will be eligible for discounts on select county programs and have the option of constructing a rain barrel at a reduced cost.

The Stormwater Academy will consist of a class session on November 5 and a rain barrel workshop on November 19. Each session will begin at 6:30 PM and conclude by 8:30 PM. Participants must register for both nights.

The November 5 class session will be held at Spinnaker's Restaurant, 11500 Midlothian Turnpike in Chesterfield Towne Center.

The November 19 rain barrel workshop will be at a location to be announced.
